PASTORAL SUPPORT

SFX understands and prioritises pastoral care and support. Our dedicated team is on call to help our students when it is needed. Every student will be allocated a tutor group and each tutor group belongs to a House headed by a member of staff who is there to offer further support and guidance.

CAREERS GUIDANCE

The Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance (CEIAG) Programme is central to each student's programme of study and progression throughout his/her college education and is designed to match students' academic progression and enhance their career plans for the future. The programme includes:

• structured careers lessons for all students

• individual careers appointments (also open to parents)

• in-house and externally organised events including a Higher Education Fair every March

- careers workshops
- job search and interview skills training
- partnerships with employers, training companies and universities

• university course taster sessions, summer schools.

CURRICULUM SUPPORT
